Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will **reopen on Monday, January 4, at 6am**. Thank you to all of our faithful adorers for another year of blessings!

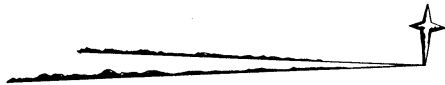
### SACRISTANS NEEDED

### YOGA CLASS BEGINNING

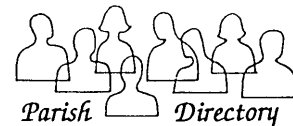
**A Yoga Class will begin at St. Jude on Monday, January 4, at 6pm.**
