Pastor's Notes

My dear friends in Christ,

Very soon we will begin our capital campaign to retire our debt and begin to create a "future maintenance" fund. This debt especially hampers not only the present but also the future. We will ask you to prayerfully consider our request for help.

As a preliminary to the campaign (and as is my custom at the end of each fiscal year, sometime shortly after June 30), we have prepared a summary of our financial statement from the fiscal year 2009-10 (July 1, 2009-June 30, 2010). Please feel free to inquire of me anything you wish to know concerning the statement. The statement is a summary from the official bookkeeping we submit to the diocese.

Also, we have updated the St. Jude Discipleship Novena that we published last winter and we invite you to begin praying it again starting on August 2. You can find it on our website and/or there are paper copies in the vestibule.

We will truly need the prayerful participation of everyone in the parish in order to accomplish the goals of our campaign. It will also take a sense of sacrifice on the part of all. The beauty of "sacri-fice" is that the word at its root means "to make holy." With prayer, participation and sacrifice, I feel that we will be able to accomplish what we set out to do as we "journey together" and "increase the holiness in our lives."

Very soon we will all receive a newsletter and a "faq" sheet (frequently asked questions) to help us discern how we might share this concern and dilemma we face as a parish family.

The "Journey Together" prayer that we have been praying together at Mass for some time now has been an effort to help us continue to unite our hearts and minds even more closely and deepen our individual and communal vision of our life here at St. Jude. There are also additional copies of the prayer in the vestibule for you to take home and pray daily if you wish.

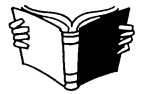
