

LETTER TO THE BISHOP

One of the requirements for the Sacrament of Confirmation is writing a personal letter to Bishop Stika requesting to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Your letter will be given to the Bishop when he joins us for lunch at a date during your Confirmation Preparation (this date will be announced at a later time). Your letter is due to Stephanie Gabor NO LATER THAN SUNDAY, JANUARY 25th.

This is a letter from you to the Bishop requesting to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. It should be addressed to: ***The Most Reverend Bishop Richard F. Stika***. This letter should be written from your heart, expressing your honest feelings about your faith life and why you are seeking Confirmation in the Catholic Church. Share with the Bishop things you have done or are doing to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. For example, any service projects you have done, why you chose your particular saint, or how you have grown spiritually during your preparation. You may also include any questions you have about your faith.

Your letter needs to be typed, should be neat and well written, and be sure to proofread your letter before printing a final copy. As always, you should be honest and respectful when writing this letter. Please sign your first and last name to your letter and put your address and telephone number below your name. **Put your letter in an envelope with your first and last name written in the top left corner and address it to: *The Most Reverend Bishop Richard F. Stika***.
